

# Crown Point Swim Club

## Participation Policy

### Winter 2010

The Crown Point Swim Club is a cooperative venture that requires parent participation for a successful program. This participation policy was designed to provide guidelines regarding the minimum amount of family involvement required in CPSC activities. Many families volunteer beyond the minimal standard required, and we encourage families to get involved.

1. ***All families*** with a swimmer(s) are required to work a minimum of **EIGHT** “sessions” over the course of the season.

The eight sessions can be fulfilled at our CPSC Fall Invitational, CPSC Winter Invitational, NWISC Conference, at the various Dual/Tri/Quad meets that get set up throughout the season and/or the Swim-a-thon; timing/officiating/working the timing system/running the Meet Manager program/possibly concessions etc.

2. At swim sign ups ***ALL families*** must write one post-dated check in the amount of \$200.00. The check should be post-dated for February 22, 2010. After working the minimum required sessions, checks will be voided and returned. Failure to work **EIGHT** required sessions will result in the forfeiture of the held deposits as of February 22, 2010.
3. All swim families will be provided various opportunities to meet their minimum participation requirements. The Meet directors will have participation sign ups 4 weeks prior to each hosted meet. The dates and times for sign ups for worker sessions will be posted on CPSC web site and a mass email reminder will be sent out with information regarding dates and times. At the participation sign up, there will be a description and details available for each job. Jobs for the meets will be filled as a first come first serve basis. The assigned jobs will be posted at the pool (bulletin board) and on the CPSC web site as soon as possible.
4. Various supervisory positions, (i.e., chair) will fulfill all session requirements with CPSC. Some examples of chairs include, but are not limited to the following:
  - 2 Meet Directors
  - 2 Chairs for concessions
  - 1 Chairs for Team Awards
  - 1 Chair for Spirit Wear
  - 1 Chair for Hospitality
  - 1 Chair for Public Relations
  - 1 Party / Banquet Chair

There may be other positions determined by the Board of Directors that are needed that can fulfill these requirements, if the need arises. Available positions will be announced at the parent’s meetings.
