Short course 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane markers, Daktronics timing system, touch pads, back-up buttons and digital watches

Entries: Entries will open at 5pm on the day of the time trial. Teams can insure that all information is correct and avoid possible delays by sending a Team Roster using Hy-Tek Team Manager via email to Coach John Krick by noon March 1 at coach.john@sbcglobal.net. All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming. Swimmers will be entered using their first, middle, and last names, age and USA swimming number as they arrive. Crown Point Swim Club requests that swimmers be entered no later than 5:30pm. However, entries will be accepted throughout the time trial. **Swimmers must supply a timer in the events that they are needed.**

Format: All events will be timed finals. CPSC will determine the order of events after everyone is entered. Swimmers may make as many attempts at an event as they like within the time frame of the time trial. Swimmers are limited to 5 events per day. The swimmers will be given adequate rest between events.

Fees: \$5.00 per event
\$1.50 Indiana Swimming surcharge per swimmer (one time charge).

Swim Suit Legislation

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Rules: Current USA swimming and Indiana swimming rules will govern this meet. USA Swimming rules 202.3.2- At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming Member coach during warm-ups, competition and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision. Please pay special attention to the starting procedures: 102.14.4 & .5. Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into the meet. Age as of March 1, 2010 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet. Coaches must constantly display their current USA Swimming coach credential to gain deck access. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credentials display and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid.

Schedule: Warm-ups start at 5:30 p.m. and will run for approximately 45 minutes.
